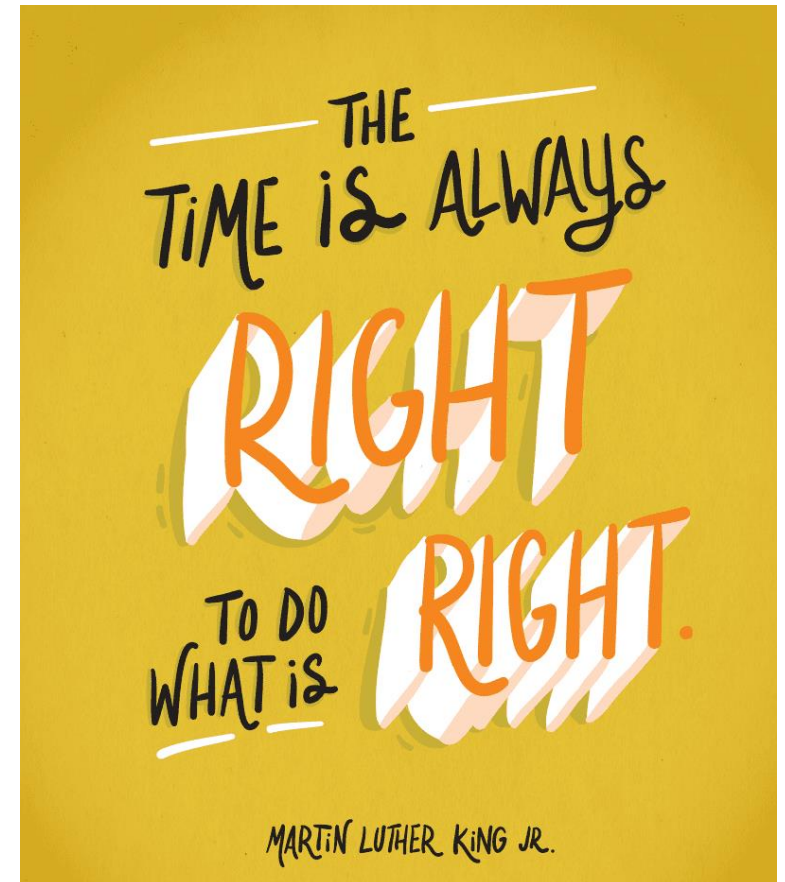
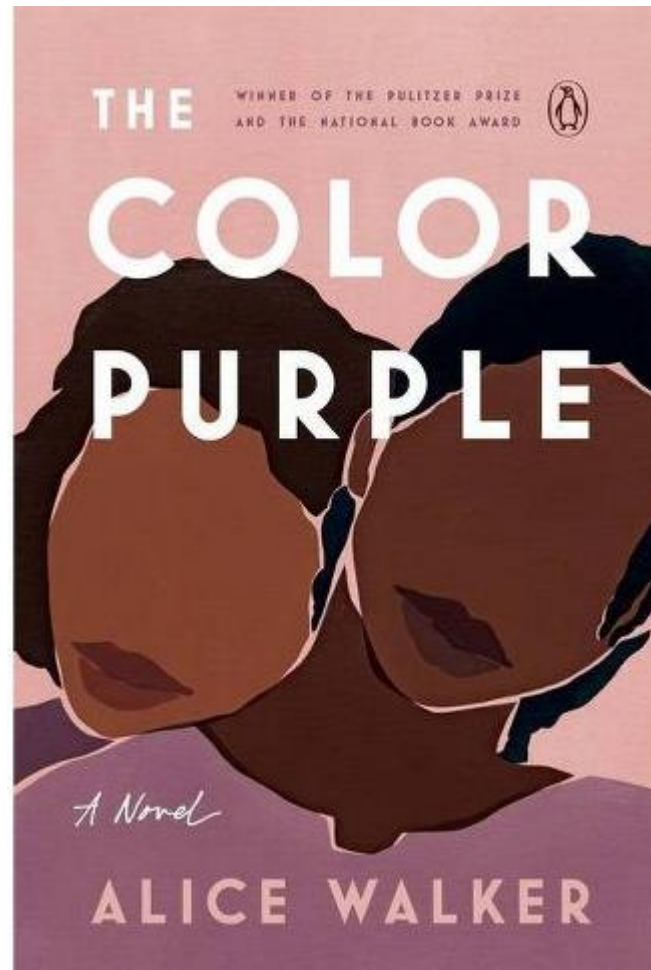

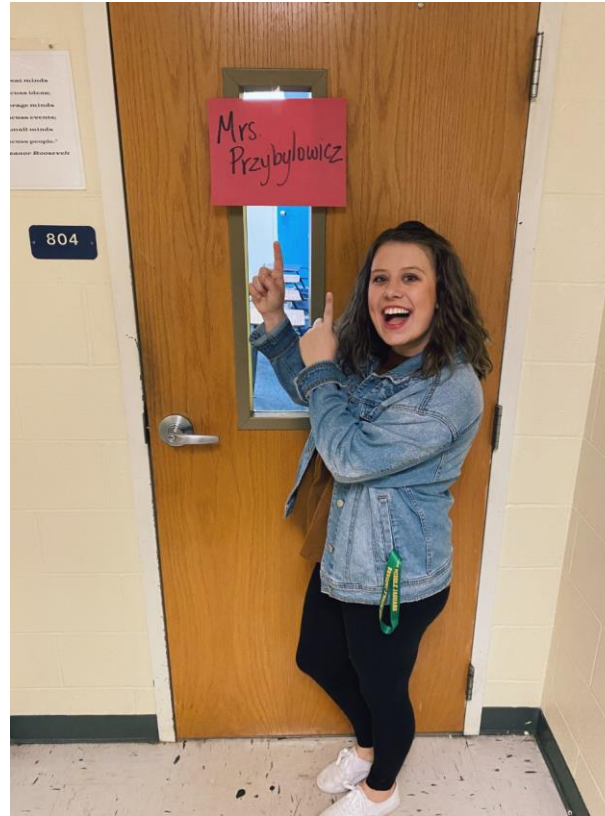
WELCOME to HMS!

Fun Fact! Ms. Mainer taught Ms. P in 7th grade ELA here at Hobbs when she was in 7th grade!



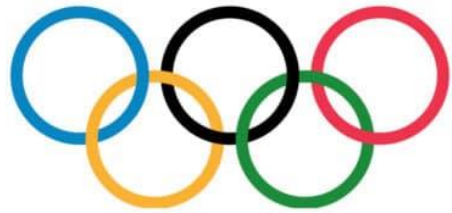
